A motion was made by Gordon Ewell to continue the appointments of David DiMatteo and David Roach as Town Prosecutor and approve the appointment of Elijah H. McWhinney as a prosecutor on behalf of DiMatteo and Roach, Attorneys at Law and the Town of Middlebury. The motion was seconded by Thomas Jaroszek and carried with all voting yes. The attached resolution was entered.

A motion was made by Craig Harkins and seconded by Thomas Jaroszek to declare Truck 195 as surplus and send the truck to Auctions International. The motion was carried with all voting yes.
